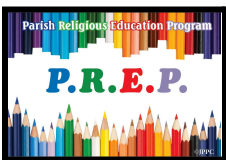

The Knights and parishioner Nathaniel Mignano installed a mailbox at Nativity Church. They added edging, mulch, and flowers to finish the project.

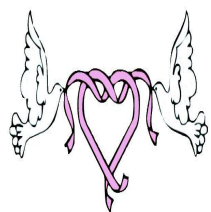


STEWARDSHIP

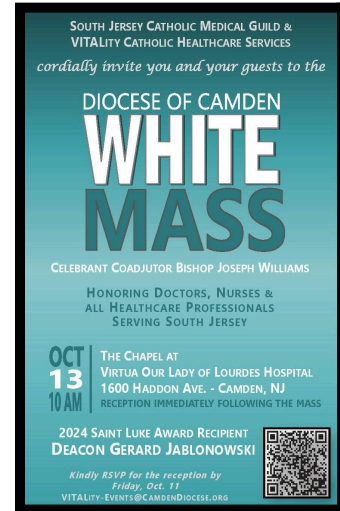

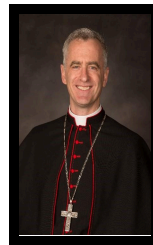

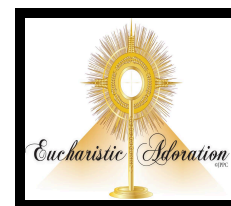
