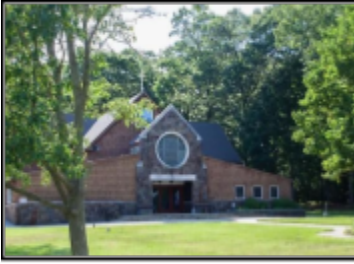

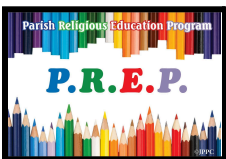

I spent over 3 days in Texas. My friend has gone all Texas on me. He drives a huge truck and likes to shoot guns. He was an Army Ranger and was in law enforcement, so he fits right in. I used to hang out with him from 7th to 10th grade. We also went to see his parents, who had not seen me in 35 years.

November 8 & 9 at 7:30PM and November 10 at 2PM

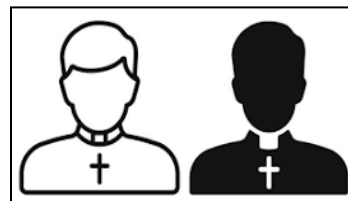
