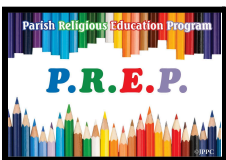

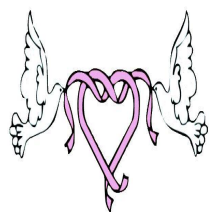


PRAYER IS POWERFUL

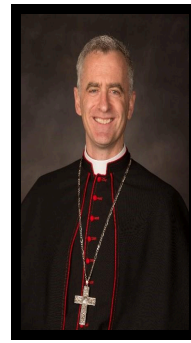
